Kitchen assistants

- Meal Prep, dining Hall Setup
- Meal Service

Custodial

- Daily Housekeeping responsibilities:
 - *Bathrooms, kitchen, office

Program

- Game assistance
- Snackshop service
- Camp store service
- Evening snack

GUY OPS

Lawn Care/facilities:

- Line trimming, push mowing, wood splitting
- Minor maintenance repairs with guidance

Custodial

- Daily trash runs
- Sweeping/mopping needed areas

Program

- Game assistance
- Occasional game set up/tear down
- Assist campers with luggage and direction at registration

DISCIPLESHIP OPPORTUNITIES WITH OPS TEENS:

- Lead daily cabin devotions in evenings
- Coordinating prayer partner and shadowing opportunities
- Individual mentoring - (i.e. - helping resolve interpersonal conflict)
- Participating in daily discipleship class (opportunities available to teach if qualified)
- Daily encouragement and teambuilding opportunities (occasional off-site as well)

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Age:** At least 20 years of age
- Time:** The entirety of the camping season - typically an 8-week summer
- What:** Solid work ethic, heart for ministry to teens and kids
- Who:** Anyone with a servant's heart, willing to work hard for the benefit of another
